Dear Educator:

This year the GKCASL would like to present the **Outstanding Secondary Library Media Program Award**. The purpose of this award is to recognize a colleague who has designed and runs an outstanding secondary library media program through their curriculum connections, collaboration efforts, and the promotion of their media center. This award helps provide visibility and public awareness of the contributions made by libraries as a part of the total educational process and, therefore, is important to all school librarians.

The nominee must be a member of GKCASL and person who works directly within the GKCASL membership area. Nominations may be made by, but are not limited to: teachers, building and district administrators, district level library coordinators/directors, or clerical personnel working directly in the school environment.

For each nomination, a complete form is to be returned to the Awards Selection Committee member named below. **Two letters** of support for the nomination need to be sent as well as the **nomination form**.

Nominations must be postmarked or sent electronically no later than January 31, 2010. The nominee must be a member of GKCASL. Once the nominations have been received, the nominated school and media specialist will be contacted in order to arrange a school visit by the committee. Once the visits have been completed, the committee will review the nominations and select the winner for this award. The Awards Selection Committee Co-Chair will notify the winner immediately. An engraved plaque will be formally presented to the recipient at the 2010 GKCASL Spring Banquet.
